Rules of Nerf Warfare

- Eye protection (i.e. goggles) will be provided and are a must.
- Stay within the public areas of the library.
- NO shooting your opponent within 10 feet of each other.
- NO shooting computer screen monitors.
- NO climbing shelving units.
- NO standing on top of furniture; you may crawl underneath furniture.
- NO open toe shoes.
- NO hitting, pinching, biting, kicking, pushing; if you can't do it in gym class you can't do it here.
- NO pushing on the shelving units.
- Long pants are required.
